Role Overview

We are looking for a **female Islamic scholar** to lead a **weekly evening halaqa** session in English, accessible to **working women, mothers, and sisters from diverse backgrounds**. The sessions will focus on building a foundational understanding of Islam, beginning with **Qur'an, Hadith, and Seerah of our beloved Prophet**, with scope for the group to grow and evolve over time.

Key Responsibilities

Religious & Educational

- Lead a weekly halaga for women in English, focusing initially on the basics of:
 - Qur'anic understanding
 - Kev Hadiths
 - Seerah of the Prophet Mohammad (pbuh)
- Create a safe, inclusive, and engaging learning environment
- Facilitate discussion, reflection, and Q&A within Islamic guidelines

- Tailor topics to suit the needs and levels of the attendees
- Share and recommend reading or follow-up resources when appropriate

Candidate Requirements

- Strong grounding in Islamic studies (e.g., Alimiyyah, BA Islamic Studies, or equivalent)
- Female, practicing Muslim with sound Islamic character
- Fluent in spoken and written English
- Able to relate well to women from diverse cultural and professional backgrounds
- Compassionate, approachable, and confident in teaching settings

Desirable

- Experience delivering halagas, study circles, or Islamic talks
- Good understanding of women's needs in Islamic education today
- Experience working with women or community engagement
- UK residency and right to work
